

# Former Local Couple Will Serve in Eire

G. Dunham, presiding minister of the Torrance Congregation of Jehovah's Witnesses, announced that Charles and Mary Rieger graduated Sunday from the Watchtower Bible School of Gilead, at South Lansing, N. Y.

They will be sent immediately to Eire as representatives of Jehovah's Witnesses. Rieger, former district supervisor, served the Torrance congregation through the semi-annual conventions at which time he addressed audiences in various cities, including Long Beach and at Wrigley Field.

Missionary School Speaking of the graduation, Rieger said, "Spreading good news earth-wide might be the theme of our unusual missionary school. The scriptural studies here at Gilead School have sharpened our appreciation of how we are living in history's most momentous time, and how our work is to show people where these events are indicated in their own Bibles and how we are at the time when this God-promised change will occur." Gilead's sole purpose, he says, is the training of Christian ministers to aid in the Witnesses' world-wide Bible educational work.
