NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Torrance does hereby enact as follows:  
SECTION 1. That the following bus loading zones be established on the following streets:  
(a) On Hawthorne Boulevard, at the northeast and southwest corner of Tullman Street.  
(b) On Hawthorne Boulevard, at the northeast and southwest corner of Halson Street.  
(c) On 174th Street, at the northeast and southwest corner of Ainsworth Avenue.  
SECTION 2. That the City Council hereby declares that the increased usage by the bus-riding public of these streets has created a traffic hazard which demands the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of all citizens, whether by automobile, bus or as pedestrians; and basing its conclusion upon the aforesaid statement, declares that an urgency exists and that this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately after the passage and adoption hereof.
