## Comic Books Reveal Kite Safety Rules

This is the time of year when kids and kites naturally get together.

But, like any other sport, there's a safe way and a wrong way to fly a kite, advises G. L. Blanchard, Southern California Edison Co. district manager.

Nearly half a million special comic books, telling the often neglected "dos and don'ts" of kite-flying safety, are being distributed free to school children by Edison.

Children and their parents can reduce needless accidents if they will remember these simple rules. First, kites should be flown in an open field, away from telephone and power lines or television antennas. Next, it is important to use only dry cotton cord. Never fly kites in the rain, and never use any form of metal in the string, kite frame or tail.

If the kite does happen to catch in a wire, the kite flyer should let go immediately instead of trying to climb a pole or pull it clear. No kite is worth a bad fall or accident of any kind.

If everyone observes these few rules, Blanchard points out, kite flying will continue to be a safe, enjoyable sport for children of all ages.

## Jaycees Will Learn About Nike Missile

Because of the local Junior Chamber of Commerce, the Torrance Tournament of Roses Assn. should be some \$2000 closer to the amount needed to sponsor the city's entry in the 1959 Pasadena classic.

The Jaycees have turned over their portion of the 1958 Rancho Days Celebration July 23-27 to complete Chamber operation as long as all proceeds are used to finance the Rose Parade entry.

A meeting will be held, announced Rancho Days chairman, Jack Phillips, on Tuesday, at 7:30 p.m. in the Chamber office. Once again, the event will be community-wide and will include the usual parade sponsored by the Chamber and conducted by Lt. D. C. Cook of the police department, a real "Wild West" Rodeo under sponsorship of the Torrance Lions and the Mounted Police, and the Chamber-sponsored Carnival Midway.

The Industry Exhibition will not be included this year, Phillips said. The committee felt it was too much of an expense to local firms to show same exhibits annually. Plans call for an interval of two to three years between the giant exhibition.

President O. R. Trueblood announced also that Bradford has been appointed general chairman of the float committee again with Mrs. Victor E. Benstead Jr. again appointed as decorations chairman.

John A. Ebbinghouse will head a committee which will try to place a local band in the classic, Trueblood said.
