Thieves Get Safe, Small Change in Two Burglaries

Thieves who dropped through a skylight to gain entrance moved a heavy safe containing \$159.40 in cash and an undetermined amount of checks from the Torrance Western Union office at 1915 W. Carson St. early Monday. Reported by Reggie Vejar after the office was opened Monday morning, the theft apparently occurred earlier in the day, detectives reported. The safe was removed through the front door of the building which had been pried open from the inside. Scuff marks at the curb showed where it had been pushed out to a waiting vehicle. A few minutes after the Western Union safe burglary was reported Monday, Jack Smith of the State Farm Insurance office around the corner at 1715 Cabrillo Ave., reported his office had been entered during the night. Thieves pried open a crank-type window in the rear of the building to gain entrance. An attempt to jimmy the rear door evidently failed. Smith reported that \$3 to \$4 in small change was taken from one of the desks in the office.
