

Polio Shots Still Needed

Poliovirus is still a threat to this community, warns Chairman Dr. Rodney Stetson of the public health committee, Torrance Chamber of Commerce.

The committee asks the help of all parents in seeing that their families are vaccinated against polio.

Dr. Stetson said that with summer comes the polio season. Some 40 million persons under age 40 still have had no vaccination or only 1 or 2 injections. Many of these will contact polio and thus keep the disease alive. The third booster dose is most necessary.

The committee urges all people in the area to go to their private physician now if they are not up to date on polio injections. Dr. B. A. Kagan, district health officer, states that polio immunizations will not be available through the local health department this summer.
