The gigantic Chamber of Commerce sponsored parade, featuring the popular Lt. Governor, on horseback as Grand Marshal, is scheduled to start at 10:30 a.m. on Saturday, July 26 and will proceed from Carson and Cabrillo north to Sartori, northwest on Sartori to Torrance Blvd., and west on Torrance Blvd. to the Civic Center.

Powers is a native Californian, born in Eagleville, Oct. 8, 1900. Educated at the University of California, "Butch" was first elected to the State Assembly in 1921. He advanced to the State Senate in 1932 and served as president pro tempore continuously until becoming Lt. Governor in 1953.

Lieutenant Cook said Powers was selected as Grand Marshal because of his great popularity as he is known to his friends, and his horsemanship.
