

L.A.'s Greek Theater Offers Varied Attraction for Summer

The Greek Theater box office opened Monday for the advance sale of tickets for the 1958 season of six attractions to be presented in the L. A.-owned amphitheater this summer. Located at the head of Vermont Ave. in Griffith Park, the box office will be open from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. every day, including Sundays, prior to the season opening June 27. Thereafter it will remain open until 9 p.m.

The entertainment quality and variety of the program this year have accounted for the heaviest season ticket orders in the history of the Greek Theater.

Opening the schedule on June 27 will be the international song idol, Maurice Chevalier, appearing for eight performances, followed by Jose Greco and his company of colorful Spanish and Flamenco dancers starting July 7.

Next will be the world-famous ballet company, "Les Ballets de Paris," starring Jeanmaire and Roland Petit in a series of three ballets featuring their interpretation of "Carmen." This company opens July 14, and will be followed by another internationally recognized artist, Danny Kaye, playing from July 21 through Aug. 3.

The final two attractions will be the spicy and witty operetta, "La Perichole" and the full length ballet, "Giselle" to be produced by James A. Doolittle, general director of the Greek Theater Assn. "La Perichole" comes almost intact from the Metropolitan Opera

Co. The same version, so successful at the Metropolitan the past two seasons, will be used. Settings and costumes will come from the eastern production. Cyril Ritchard will direct and star as he did in New York, and many of the original cast which includes: Osie Hawkins, Madeline Chambers, Theodor Uppman, and ballerina Micheline Bardin will play their roles in the local engagement.

"Giselle" will be the first American production of the complete full length version of the ballet, and its dancing stars will be the world famous Alicia Alonso and Igor Youskevitch. Miss Alonso will stage the ballet as she did "Coppelia," a sold out success on last year's program at the Greek Theater. "La Perichole" will play from Aug. 6 through the 16th, and "Giselle," Aug. 18 through the 23rd.


