Dr. Ellenhorn To Deliver Temple Sermon

Dr. Matthew J. Ellenhorn, president of Temple Menorah of the South Bay, will deliver the sermon at services to be conducted at 8:30 p.m. tomorrow at the temporary Temple building, 112 North Catalina, Redondo Beach. His topic will be "Dangerous Thoughts."

Later this month, Dr. Ellenhorn will travel to London, England, to attend the annual convention of the World Union for Progressive Judaism, to which he has been appointed a delegate from the United States, representing the Union of American Hebrew Congregations, the lay organization which is the parent body of Temple Menorah. His wife, Syma Ellenhorn, has been appointed an alternate delegate, representing the National Federation of Temple Sisterhoods. Mrs. Ellenhorn is a vice-president of the Temple Menorah Sisterhood this year.

The World Union was established after the Second World War to assist in the establishment of Progressive Jewish congregations throughout the world. Delegates from the United States, England, France, Israel, South Africa, Australia, Canada, Mexico, and other foreign countries will gather to discuss future plans of the Union. Upon his return to Southern California, Dr. Ellenhorn will be speaking to many Jewish organizations about the work of the Union and the results of this convention.
