Pursuant to the provisions of the Labor Code of the State of California, the County of Los Angeles has ascertained the prevailing rate of per diem wages in dollars, based on a working day of eight hours, for each craft or type of workman or mechanic engaged on the project. Provided that notwithstanding the general provisions of the Labor Code, Guards and Watchmen shall be paid one and one-half times the prevailing rate for each hour worked in excess of eight hours per day or forty hours per week, and the straight prevailing rate for time worked on Saturdays, Sundays, and where such time does not constitute overtime.

The rates of per diem wages for each of the various classifications of work shall be as hereinafter set forth prevailing rates of hourly wages multiplied by eight. Eight hours shall constitute a day's work; it being understood that in the event that workmen are employed less than eight hours per day, the rate of per diem wages shall be deemed to be that fraction of the rate of per diem wages established that the number of hours of employment bears to eight hours.
