

National Guard Opens Door to New Enlistees

Limitation on enlistments in the California National Guard was lifted this week, opening the door to hundreds of young men who have been on the waiting list for the six months active duty program, according to Major General Homer O. Eaton Jr., Commanding General of Southern California's 40th Armored Division.

With this announcement, the General said, all units of the 40th Armored Division will be allowed to enlist local men without prior military service.

Positions are still available to prior service personnel, he stated.

Enlistments, which in the past have been limited, are now available in aviation, engineers, ordnance, artillery, signal, tank and armored infantry battalions.


