

Widows of Retired Railroaders Must Still Count Annuities

Veterans on railroad retirement were recently advised of a new law (Public Law 86-28) which provides that the recipient of a nonservice-connected pension from the Veterans Administration will no longer be required to include his railroad retirement annuity as income.

This means veterans who have waived all or part of their railroad retirement in order to qualify for the VA pen-

sion should revoke that waiver immediately. Veterans Service Officer Bessie D. Stonecker pointed out today, however, that the income limitations for widows of such veterans have not been changed by the new law. Unless later ruled otherwise, he said, widows receiving pensions and annuities under the Railroad Retirement Act must still consider such benefits as income for purposes of VA death pension.

The new public law states that "pensions and annuities under this act or the Railroad Retirement Act of 1935 shall not be considered as income for the purposes of Section 522, Title 38 of the U.S. Code." Section 522 contains the income limitations for veterans' pension, but income limitations for widows' pensions are contained in Section 545, which is not amended by the new law.

Meanwhile, the Railroad Retirement Board has been notifying veteran ex-railroaders who may wish to revoke their waiver of all or a part of their annuities, as these annuities no longer affect their income limitations.

Those veterans who are entitled to VA pension, but have not heretofore filed for it because their railroad retirement pay placed them over the income ceiling, should file as soon as possible with the Veterans Service Office, at 1622 Gramercy, Torrance.

To be eligible for pension, a veteran must be unemployable due to physical handicaps or the infirmities of old age, and have reportable income of less than \$1,400 if single or \$2,700 if he has dependents.


