Garden Checklist

1. Freesias and other cape bulbs will be available for planting later this month and next. The sooner they go in, the better.
2. When cutting Dahlias for display indoors, pound the bases of the stems with a hammer hard enough to crush them. This aids water absorption.
3. Take only short stems when cutting Tuberous Begonias and let the remainder of the stem stay on the plant until it falls naturally. This prevents possible rot.
4. Perennials such as Delphinium can still be sown for fall boom next spring or summer. Pansies, Winter Stocks, Snapdragons and Cineraria can be seeded for cool season color.
5. Prepare the seedbed for that lawn you plan to sow next month. Ask your nurseryman about a compound that will eliminate weeds and weed seeds from the area to be planted.
