

Wyoming Senator to Speak To Executive Club Dinner

Members of the Executive Club of the Torrance Area will have an opportunity to hear an authority on current national problems when United States Senator Gale W. McGee comes here on the evening of Saturday, Oct. 31.

The dinner will be held at the Plush Horse. Senator McGee, a former university professor of history, won election to the United States Senate from Wyoming last November by defeating the veteran Republican incumbent Senator Frank A. Barrett.

With his rich background of history and as a repeated visitor to Moscow, Dr. McGee gives a penetrating down to earth appraisal of Russia's international policy and its impact on our standard of living. His interpretations are invigorating and thought provoking. Born in Nebraska, the senator and former educator received his degrees from Nebraska State Teachers College, the University of Colorado, and the University of Chicago.

He was Assistant Professor of History at the University of Wyoming and held this position when he was selected to the United States Senate. Recognized as an outstanding speaker, Dr. McGee is especially popular with dinner club audiences because of his analytical and practical approach to his subject.

Dr. J. H. Hull, president of the local group, said that McGee is the second Senator to attend this year's schedule of Executive Club meetings. Senator Karl E. Mundt, Republican, of South Dakota spoke here in January.


