Scientist Gives View Of Russia

An awesome but realistic picture of Communist Russia as a menace to civilization was etched in the minds of a distinguished audience of the Rolling Hills Toastmaster Club at a dinner meeting in WALTERIA last week.

Bart Ewell, a technological engineer of the Shell Oil Co., a student of world affairs and a veteran Toastmaster, spoke to the group at the Fish Shanty.

"Many people think," Ewell said, "that because the Soviet government was able to launch a sputnik, Russia has become far advanced in technology, even further, perhaps, than the United States."

"Nothing could be farther from the truth," he said.

Civic League To Discuss Health Area

Proposed changes in the existing county health ordinance will be discussed at the regular quarterly meeting of the Lomita Civic League, to be held Oct. 1 at 8 p.m. in the auditorium of the Lomita Elementary School at 247th and Narbonne. The division of the county into health districts, and the jurisdiction in Lomita of the county health center located in Torrance will be explained.

The speaker will come from the Sanitation Division of the County Health Department, and will define the jurisdiction of the Health Department as distinguished from that of the Building and Safety Department, which has control over such matters as the use of trailers outside of trailer parks, and reconditioning of houses which have been moved.

The Civic League has asked the County Health Department for an opinion as to whether the department has jurisdiction over unwholesome conditions due to the failure of a local water company to furnish sufficient water for household use.

The public is invited to attend the meeting. A special invitation is extended to newcomers in the community.
