

VA Approves Benefits for Enemy Aliens

Veterans Service Officer Bessie D. Slonecker noted today that the Veterans Administration has been authorized, by newly signed Public Law 86-113, to pay benefits to certain veterans discharged as enemy aliens unless the discharge was at their own request.

During World War I, instructions were issued by the Secretary of War that aliens in the U.S. military service, who were from countries with which we were at war, should be discharged if they so requested.

However, the instructions were misunderstood in some cases and many such aliens were discharged arbitrarily. Those who wanted to remain in service were therefore the victims of an injustice, because they were grouped with the aliens who did request discharge and were subsequently denied any veterans benefits.

The new law provides that no individual will be considered to have been discharged as an alien at his own request unless there is affirmative evidence that he was so discharged.

Prior to the new law, an alien veteran who applied for benefits was required to prove to the satisfaction of the VA that he was not discharged at his own request. Thus, the burden of proof has been switched from the veteran to the military authorities.

Besides the many veterans who gain entitlement to benefits from PL 86-113, their dependents and survivors become similarly entitled to corresponding benefits.

Rivierans to Discuss Type Of Lighting
