Suit Against Small Craft and Harbor Loan Act Out of Court

A Judge of the Superior Court of Sacramento County has dismissed a complaint brought by the California Harbor and Resort Owners' Assn. (a comparatively new organization), which challenged the constitutionality of the California State Small Craft Harbor Loan program.

The suit had been filed against the Division of Small Craft Harbors and is understood to have alleged that the State could not validly engage in a program of assistance loans to communities in the building of harbor facilities. It is still possible for the plaintiff to amend the original complaint, allege other grounds, or appeal the case, but it is unlikely that any of these steps will be taken.

THE CALIFORNIA State Small Craft Harbor Loan laws, all of which I helped enact into law, were originally proposed by me at a meeting of the old Joint Interim Committee of Marine Affairs, and again when I was chairman of the Assembly Committee on Marine Affairs.

The basis of these laws is a revolving loan fund, whereby communities borrow money from the State and pay it back over a period of years. In the long run, it costs the taxpayers nothing, and also increases the assessed value of land within several miles of each boat harbor.

THE UNITED States Supreme Court has, by a 5 to 4 vote, rendered an important decision affecting water pollution. It ruled that the United States has the power under an old Federal statute (Rivers and Harbors Act of 1899) to prohibit factories from discharging industrial waste into navigable rivers that result in a reduction of the navigable capacity of the stream.

THE U.S. Supreme Court case involved three corporations, Republic Steel, International Harvester, and Interlake Iron Corp. The United States sought to enjoin these corpora-

tions from discharging industrial wastes into the Calumet River near Chicago.

The U. S. Army Corps of Engineers, which is responsible for maintaining a 21-foot channel in the Calumet River, testified that the corporations were causing a menace to navigation in that fine particles of various solid materials discharged into the Calumet River through sewers had a tendency to solidify and settle to the bottom of the Calumet River and had, in some places, reduced the depth of the river channel to 12 feet instead of the necessary 21 feet.

MY ASSEMBLY Bills Numbered 1086 and 1087 became laws in 1957 to reduce the pollution of our bays and harbors. One of them took most of the authority away from the Regional and State Water Pollution Control Boards, which had done nothing except hold meetings, and restored the basic authority to the California State Board of Public Health, which had exercised such authority originally.

Then, when the State Board of Public Health regained its authority under my law, it reduced the pollution affecting Santa Monica Bay, particularly the shores of Playa del Rey, Manhattan Beach, Hermosa Beach, and Redondo Beach. The greatest improvement was seen at Manhattan Beach, and it's only fair to report that Thomas P. Foye, an attorney who lives in Manhattan Beach, and was for several years its mayor, spent hundreds of hours of his time and much of his own money in helping me correct the intolerable situation at Manhattan Beach.

ALTHOUGH the U. S. Supreme Court Decision relates to the Calumet River near Chicago, the basic principle applies to streams flowing into Santa Monica Bay, hence it strengthens my two California laws regarding water pollution.
