me. I have realized since my first meeting with the city officials of Torrance that they did not explain the full impact of the court decision involving the park.

"I also realize that Lawndale officials did not explain that they had further plans to annex territory as far away as Rosecrans and Van Ness," he said.

NO CITY wanted to annex the park when he first became supervisor of the district, Hahn pointed out. He said the park "even had slum housing in the northwest section."

Reviewing the development during his tenure, Hahn pointed to improvement of the swimming pool, bathhouse, beach area, picnic area, enlarged parking, improvement to the lake, new bridge to the island, landscaping, a bridge across Dominguez Channel to the El Camino parking lot, and the clearing of the northeast section and installation of a recreation building, two softball fields, a baseball diamond, and landscaping.

OTHER improvements have been scheduled in the near future, the Supervisor pointed out, including future development of a "Treasure Island" on the lake island.

"I very much regret that now these major improvements have been made that the park has become a point of contention between neighboring cities—particularly when the outcome will not change the status a bit, since the county will still maintain, operate, and improve it."
