Motorists Warned by CHP On Illegal Trailer Hitches

The California Highway Patrol has issued a warning to motorists whose cars are equipped with trailer hitches to make certain the hitch does not cover the license plate in violation of the state vehicle code. License plates on nearly all late model automobiles are located in the center of the bumper and are easily obscured by many types of trailer hitches. "When this occurs," declared CHP Commissioner Bradford M. Crittenden, "the trailer hitch is illegal and the motorist is subject to arrest. The license plate must be in a position to be clearly visible and this requirement is not met when the hitch is in the way." The CHP official suggested solving the problem by either removing or modifying the hitch when it is not in use or by installing one that can be adjusted so that it does not cover the license plate.


New Hours Slated at City Plunge
