


## School District To Fete 10-Year Staff Members

## NAA Testing Ejection Aid Designed by Horkey-Moore

A pair of stabilizing booms attached to the escape capsules installed in North American Aviation's B-70 Valkyrie will provide ejected airmen with a smooth descent if ejection from the Mach 3 bomber becomes necessary.

Designed and fabricated by Horkey-Moore Assoc., the long cylindrical booms will serve as stabilizers for the rocket-propelled encapsulated seat during ejection into free-flight and until the recovery parachute slows descent.

The encapsulated seat was designed in a "shirt-sleeve" environment while providing protection if it is necessary to

leave the craft — even at speeds above 2000 mph. The booms provide aerodynamic stability, exerting lift and drag forces orientated to the capsule's center of gravity. Tumbling is eliminated while the occupant remains in a sitting position.

A solid fuel rocket hurls the capsule and rider 380 ft. above the Valkyrie's tail—high enough to insure parachute inflation even at low altitudes.

The encapsulated seat and its stabilizing booms are being tested by North American Aviation. Horkey-Moore is a division of Houston Fearless Corporation.
