


Tidelands Oil Drilling Meets Various Obstacles in Vicinity

Oil drilling along the coast of the 46th Assembly District is a subject of continuing interest.

Years ago, I obtained a grant to the City of Manhattan Beach from the State so that Manhattan Beach owns its own tidelands for police purposes (that is, health, safety and law - enforcement of all types), but I could not obtain a grant including oil, gas and mineral rights which were reserved by the State.

THOSE WHO want to read the whole law, including my protective section, should get some lawyer to let them read Section 6871.2 of his copy of the Public Resources Code. However, it is possible for any citizen to write to the Legislative Bill Room, State Capitol, Sacramento 14, California, and obtain two copies of Assembly Bill No. 3402, 1955 Regular Session, California State Legislature, free, as long as the supply lasts.

My protective amendment to the law is of interest not only to those living along the coast of the 46th Assembly District, but also to everyone who uses the beaches, including the residents of Inglewood, Lennox, and Westchester (L.A. 45). For example, my protective amendment included the City of Santa Monica, which recently held an election and decisively defeated an effort to authorize oil drilling on its shore.

REDONDO BEACH owns its own tidelands, including oil, gas and mineral rights, and it has oil wells producing revenue which is being used by the City for beach and harbor improvement.

The City of Palos Verdes in the past has several times informed me that it did not want a grant of tidelands, hence tidelands belongs to the State, although the majority of the people apparently do not want oil drilling. This statement is based on letters I have received and not as the result of municipal elections as in the case of the City of Hermosa Beach.

IN GENERAL, the remainder of the coast of the 46th Assembly District was open to oil drilling by the State, including Playa del Rey, El Segundo, Manhattan Beach, Palos Verdes Estates, Portuguese Bend, portions of San Pedro lying within the 46th Assembly District, and both Santa Catalina Island and San Clemente Island. Therefore, I looked for an opportunity to protect the shoreline against oil drilling by the State where people did not want it.

On Jan. 21, 1955, the Honorable Joseph Shell introduced his Assembly Bill No. 3402. I amended it to prohibit the drilling for oil by the State in

PLEASE understand that in various elections regarding oil drilling along the shore of Hermosa Beach, I have never aligned myself with either side. I stay out of school district, municipal, and county disputes. This is in accord with my theory that it is my job to represent the people in the Legislature but not my job to tell them what to do. Any other attitude would be contradictory to the fundamental principles of American life.
