

Contract for Alondra Park Improvements Let by Board

Continuing with Supervisor Kenneth Hahn's program to improve and develop Alondra Park into one of the finest regional recreational centers in Southern California, the Board of Supervisors this week awarded construction contract for major improvements in the northwest section of the park and approved preliminary plans for development of approximately eight acres in the northeast portion of the park.

Under terms of the improvement contract awarded to the low bidder, the Geisler Construction Co., work will start in the northwest section within 30 days.

Improvements include site development and landscaping construction of two picnic shelters, a new playground with new equipment, picnic tables, benches, stoves and braziers, drinking fountains, sinks, off-street parking, park lighting, and a new comfort station.

The new playground area will be located south of the new parking lot, which will front on Manhattan Beach Blvd. The playground will be filled with sand for protection of children using the equipment which will include a tepee, viking ship, flying saucer, turtle family, train, sinking

A COMPLETE new lawn will be planted over the entire eight acre development.
