Garden Checklist

1. If you want an exotic touch in the window this winter, try a potted orchid. When you select one, make sure it will bloom during the winter months. Your nurseryman will know.
2. Plant the large hybrid Lilies as soon as you get them home from the nursery. They never really go dormant and cannot be stored like other bulbs.
3. Ranunculus can be planted right through the first part of next year for a long succession of bloom in spring.
4. Plant annuals for winter and spring color; perennials for spring and summer color.
5. Plant Bird of Paradise this month and enjoy its fall to spring bloom.
