### Give Home That Festive Look With Inside, Outside Decor

This Christmas all over America, homes will be like young butterflies spreading their wings... unfolding a blaze of color and light!

Outdoor decorations will range from large, expensive, mechanically powered displays to one small wreath of neighborliness and hospitality at this Holiday Season.

Doors, and a picture window if you have one, are the best spots to start your decorating. They are "naturals" as focal points.

**YOUR WALK** serves as a "frame" for the doorway as seen from the street... so don't forget that.

But, here are two important hints to keep in mind: (1) Be sure your display is not a clutter. Feature one design, and use all other items to enhance that. And, (2) be sure your displays are weatherproof. This is particularly important where lights are used.

BESIDES LIGHTS, tinsel,

greenery, cut-outs, etc. which you know work for good displays... you can use casein paint to decorate your door, garage, windows, or what-have-you... it goes on easily and washes off quickly.

Remember, that rain and snow can smear it or wash it off... so use casein paint only where it is protected. Test it on a small area first... just to be sure!

Consider talking to your neighbors this year about having a coordinated display. It's a good "excuse" for getting to know your neighbors better... and can make yours a neighborhood the whole town will be proud to show off!

#### Put a Petticoat 'Round Your Tree

Rather than using cotton to cover the base of your tree this year, why not plan to make a gay petticoat.

These can be made quickly with felt and a pair of pinking shears. Cut a hole in the middle and slash from outer edge to fit around tree trunk. Scallop with pinking shears and decorate to your taste.

It's a labor saver too as it will catch needles and can be easily removed and dumped to make cleaning easier.
