Nine Prominent Speakers Slated For Annual Bible Lectureship

The compatibility of this complex age and an institution nearly two thousand years old provides the theme for the Redondo Beach Church of Christ's Annual Bible Lectureship, "The 20th Century Church," it was announced today.

Nine interesting and well-known ministers, educators, and lecturers from the Greater Los Angeles Area have been selected to speak. The public is invited to attend this series of lectures 7:30 p.m. each evening, beginning January 8 and continuing through January 15th at the Redondo Beach Church of Christ, 6122 Pacific Coast Highway.

Dr. J. P. Sanders, Dean of George Pepperdine College; Dr. Howard A. White, Historian; Dr. Logan Fox, president of Ibaraki Christian College in Japan; Dr. Warren S. Jones, College Speech Department Head; Vance Carruth, minister; William Slater Banowsky, speech instructor; Donald M. Osborne, minister; H. Frank Cope, lecturer; and John W. Young, minister, are the speakers chosen for this year's lectureship.

DR. SANDERS will open the series Sunday. Speaking at the 10:50 a.m. worship service and again in the evening, his topics will be "The Church in Prophecy" and "It's Establishment." Dr. Sanders, professor of religion, was formerly Dean of David Lipscomb College, Nashville, Tenn., for 14 years. He attended Vanderbilt University, is a graduate of Texas Christian University, and received his doctorate at the University of California.

Monday evening, Dr. Howard A. White will lecture on "The Church and It's Past 20 Centuries." Dr. White is minister of the Westchester Church of Christ and College Department Head of Social Science. He attended David Lipscomb College and received his degree from Tulane University. Dr. White was a minister in the Southern States for many years.

"THE CHURCH and the Community" will be the topic for Mr. Donald M. Osborne's lecture on Tuesday evening. Osborne, formerly minister in Costa Mesa and Westminister, is now the minister of the Hermosa Beach Church of Christ. He has attended David Lipscomb and Wheaton Colleges, and is now engaged in post graduate work in addition to his regular ministerial duties.

Born in Japan, of missionary parents, and a resident of that country for 25 years, Dr. Logan Fox will speak Wednesday evening on "Sending the Gospel Abroad." Dr. Fox was a missionary in Japan for 12 years, having returned to this country early last year. President of Ibaraki Christian College in Japan, he is at present on leave of absence and serving as Associate Professor of Psychology at Pepperdine College.

VANCE CARRUTH, minister of Bellflower Church of Christ, will discuss "20th Century Stewardship" on Thursday evening. Mr. Carruth, a native of Texas, graduate of Abilene Christian College and the University of Southern California, was in the past minister of the South Gate and Buena Park Churches of Christ. Grandson of the late Will W. Slater, well-known Hymn Book editor, William Slater Banowsky, South Gate Church of Christ minister, will speak Friday concerning "20th Century Music." Instructor of Speech and Bible, he recently returned from an extensive speaking tour of Asia and the Far East. Mr. Banowsky attended David Lipscomb College, University of New Mexico and the University of Southern California.
