

Albert Charles Calls for New Board Strength

"I have two children in the Torrance school system and I'm not satisfied with the quality of training they are receiving," says Albert W. Charles, 5470 Riviera Way, who is seeking one of the three board of education seats at stake in the April 18 school election.

"I feel strongly that the problems of the Torrance system start at the top," he said. He emphasizes that by the "top," he means the school board.

Charles, who was raised in Corning, N.Y., enlisted in the Royal Canadian Air Force on completing high school in 1941, and later transferred to the U.S. Air Force. He was honorably discharged in 1946.

HE RECEIVED a bachelor of science degree from Centenary College in Shreveport, La., in 1950; a master of business administration from Auburn in 1953, and is currently pursuing doctoral studies in economics in the evenings at the University of Southern California. He joined AirResearch as a job analyst in 1951 and was later named employment manager. Five years ago he joined Paper Mate as director of industrial relations, and left a year ago to open his own consulting firm, The Charles Co.

HE AND his wife, Margie, have two daughters, Sandra, 12, and Charlotte, 14. He has resided in Torrance for six years. "We need a strong, hard-working school board composed of individuals who will see to it that the administrative officials carry out the policies established by the school board; and, at the same time, discourage the practice of having administrative officials establish policy," Charles says.

CHARLES believes the school board members should be able to review proposed expenditures and have a good idea whether the expenditures will further the goal of providing better education. "The school board should make sure that the superintendent of schools understands the difference between administration and policy making," Charles states. He adds that the board should see that "policies are administered in the spirit intended."

"WE CAN'T afford the luxury of wasting out human potential," he states. "Many of the unemployables we read about are the products of an inadequate or improperly managed school system."

Charles has a word for parents, also, saying they have a responsibility to cooperate with teachers in establishing sound study habits.

"It means you will have to keep the TV off once in a while, and force your son or daughter to study," he said.
