Coast Guard to 'Ride Herd' on Boats During Buccaneer Days Fete

Safe escort for the more than 100 small craft expected to sail across the channel to Catalina Island during Buccaneer Days celebrations the first and second week ends in May, has been assured today by the U. S. Coast Guard.

Final orders and instructions have been issued by Coast Guard headquarters following a special meeting called for members of the USCG Auxil-

ary Corps for this purpose, it was stated.

THE 124-FOOT Coast Guard cutter Diligence under command of Lt. M. L. Black, together with six Auxiliary vessels, will be assigned to the sailing area Saturday, April 30, and Sunday, May 1, starting patrol of the channel waters


Radio frequency 2182 kilocycles, Coast Guard Distress, will be monitored at all times during both week ends, the headquarters communication assured. Anyone in need of information while under way, or in need of help, should call on

this frequency immediately, it is stressed.

Comdr. C. E. McDowell, USCG, in charge of Coast Guard Search and Rescue, today had issued the statement that "due to a three-day blow the previous year, we feel no one should risk the channel crossing alone, but should avail of the escort service provided."

THE COMMANDER further stated "the need for distress flares are of utmost importance for any craft planning to travel during the hours of darkness."

AERONCA GETS NEW B-70 PARTS JOB

Aeronca was placed back in to the B-70 program when North American Aviation of Los Angeles authorized the firm to proceed with the production of a series of brazed stainless steel honeycomb structures for the "Valkyrie."

While actual money figures were not released, W. W. Rutledge, vice president - Defense products group, said the contract was "sizeable." The contract received from North American authorizes

Aeronca to begin work on the B-70's prototype unit immediately.

IN MAKING the award, North American raised Aeronca for its success in this new field of manufacturing stainless steel honeycomb structures.

This recently developed technique provides a high strength material for the B-70, which will fly continuously, over long distances, at speeds three times faster than sound. Conventional aircraft materials such as aluminum, lose their strength at the high temperatures which will be developed.

ACCORDING TO Rutledge, the production units required for the B-70's development are largest brazed stainless steel honeycomb structures built. The manufacture involves major programs in tooling, process development, welding and quality control along with the brazing.

Rutledge said that one of the structures is a panel over 30 feet long and 15 feet wide

—nearly the size of a passenger transit bus. "We are extremely pleased to be back in the very vital B-70 program," Rutledge said. "We hope that the decision to build a prototype is only the beginning and that the complete B-70 program will be re-instated soon."
