MODEL BATTLE SCENE IN FRANCE WINS HONORS FOR TWO HOBBYISTS

Winners of third place at the annual Los Angeles Hobby Show were two Torrance boys, Steve Bailey, 16, and Art Linnemeyer, 16.

The boys, who will enter their junior year at South High School next fall, built a scale replica of a World War II battle scene taking place in a French village.

Their work took five months to complete and won third prize in its division at the Shrine Auditorium where the Hobby Show is held every year.

The exhibit will be on display all week (June 20-25) in the Harbor Savings and Loan Assn. lobby at 1613 S. Pacific Coast Hwy.

Action in the battle scene shows the village held by German troops being besieged by US Tank and Infantry forces. Every detail was built to scale from raw materials by Bailey and Linnemeyer, except the tank models and soldiers. It is constructed of plaster of Paris and balsa wood. More than 40 pounds of plaster and

55 feet of wood were used to complete the model. Young Bailey lives at 114 Calle de Arboles and Art Linnemeyer at 802 Miramar.

Sunday also will mark the beginning of Youth Week. The youth of the church will take over most of the responsibilities of the adults.


Keith Coble will serve as youth pastor, Glen Aycock as Sunday School superintendent, Bill McKee as Training Union director.
