

Motorists Told to Drive Autos As Though Under Enemy Attack

So dangerous has the automobile become that one group of safety experts recently suggested that the individual drive as though under enemy attack, forever on the lookout for danger that may come from another driver or a pedestrian.

The suggestion might be a good one at that, for some 63 per cent of the persons hospitalized for injuries during the fiscal year 1958-59 were victims of automobile accidents.

A CONTINUING automobile accident study, carried on by the Cornell University Automotive Crash Injury Project, shows that of the 30,000 lives lost in the nation annually through motor vehicle accidents at least 5500 could be saved by the use of the car safety belt.

This research project also disclosed that major injuries resulting from automobile accidents could be reduced about 30 per cent if seat belts were installed in all cars. Nevertheless, despite this report, comparatively few cars are so equipped, and new car dealers report that safety belts are the hardest of all the "extras" to sell.

MOST DRIVERS know that a car is safer to drive when in good mechanical condition, that safe driving practices should be followed, and that the person behind the wheel of a car should never rely on the other driver to do the right thing. However, fewer persons are aware of the extent that an individual's physical condition may influence his driving.

It is a well known fact that a sleepy driver is just as much of a menace on the road as a drinking one, but safety experts are of the opinion that emotional upsets can also turn a normally safe driver into a dangerous one. Certainly when a person is greatly disturbed he is much less likely to keep his mind on the wheel.

ONLY A DOCTOR can tell whether a person with certain nerve and heart disorders can drive a car with safety, and

the individual must rely on his physician's judgment. The same is true of diabetic patients who may possibly be subject to an insulin reaction. Usually, however, when diabetic patients follow the doctor's directions carefully, they are considered physically fit to drive.

A more common danger on the road is the person who does himself with various medicaments including antihistamines, sedatives, tranquilizers, and the like. Such drugs may dull the reflexes and impair co-ordination thereby reducing driving fitness.

GOOD EYESIGHT is exceedingly important in safe driving, yet many people who get their eyes tested regularly are unaware that the common cold or hay fever can blur the vision dangerously when the attack is in the acute stage. When these ailments are troublesome, extra caution is needed when driving.

Dark glasses are often used by motorists to soften the glare of the sun, and these do lessen eye strain during the daylight hours. When worn during night driving, however, they are a menace to safety. Colored glass in windshields may also be dangerous at night if the tinting is too dark.

AUTOMOBILE accidents have been a major cause of death and injury for many years, and the situation is not getting any better. Never trust anybody's driving, is the advice given to both driver and pedestrian and, indeed, don't trust yourself if any of the aforementioned hazards are present or even suspected.
