

BAGS TO STRIKES

**Kathy Koepke
Rolls 288 in
Bowling Classic**

Eight down and four to go—that's the story of the qualifying rounds of the Southland's richest guaranteed singles classic—the 3rd Annual Blue Grass Singles Classic which is offering bowlers of all averages a record-breaking pot of gold in excess of \$103,700. Since May 29th bowlers from every section of the Southland have been competing not only for the guaranteed weekly prize fund of \$4,800 but also for a position in the semi-finals which could lead to a \$1000 cash prize for the four men's champions and \$500 for the four women's champions.

THERE IS still another incentive—a \$1000 bonus for the top series bowled in each of the eight classes during the 12 weeks of qualifying and a \$250 bonus to the highest game turned in in each of the eight classes during the qualifying action. As the eighth week of qualifying went into the record books Monday, more than 1900 entrants shared in the prize fund of \$39,000 which has already been awarded to the high scorers. Despite this gigantic melon, more than \$64,500 remains to be distributed in the four remaining weeks of qualifying, the semi-final and final rounds.

IN THE 8th week of action, two fair damsels took a giant step toward the bonus awards of \$25 as Kathy Koepke notched a ten-bagger and a 288 game at Bowl-O-Drome, the highest single to date in the women's Class 2.

At Victory Bowling Center Frances Hough kegged a fancy 258 to take over high game laurels in women's Class 3. The twosome joined a list of more than 240 bowlers who received dividends for their strike-and-spare ability.

Other redhot performances turned in during the hot-weather week included a 715 series by Bart Tulanian at Victory Bowling Center; Ray Pinheiro's 290-704 performance at Bowl-O-Drome; Leonard Wise's 681 at Lakewood; Don Hudson's 642 at Panorama; Wilma Guillory's 647 at Lakewood; Irene Bliss' 658 at Bowl-O-Drome; Helen Hylander's 625 at Panorama Bowl; Ethel Rathel's 575 at Baldwin Park Bowl; and Jim Gerkin's 280 beauty at Palos Verdes Bowl.

WITH LESS than 28 qualifying days remaining, the 15 participating houses are assuring all entrants open lanes eight up to the qualifying deadline of 2 p.m. Sunday, August 21st.

San Diego Man Wins Chevy Station Wagon in Yellowtail Derby

SAN DIEGO, July 27—Addition of another link to the chain of amazing success of San Bernardino anglers in major fishoffs of the \$25,000 San Diego Yellowtail Derby and the meteoric rise of qualifying weight in the newly launched third period of the derby today were main topics of conversation here.

Heavy run of albacore, still gaining momentum, accounted for the jump in qualifying weight, which at the end of one week stood at 28 pounds 6 ounces in the albacore-tuna division. At the same time, minimum for yellowtail stood at 18 pounds.

Bob Adams, composing room employee of the Sun Telegram, took the derby fishoff last Friday with a 30 pound 13 ounce yellow caught at the Coronado Islands from Chuck McLeod's Sea Boots.

Adams' victory gave him the keys and title to a 1960 Chevrolet Station wagon but not the \$1490.50 jackpot in the Boosters' Bonanza. Last minute ticket switch with another angler so that Adams could go on the boat of his choice fouled up registrations.


