Nearly 1000 High School Seniors Set to Graduate

Graduation days for nearly 1000 high school seniors and 1900 eighth grades in Torrance schools will be coming up next Wednesday and Thursday. Graduation ceremonies at North, South, and Torrance High Schools all will take place at 8 p.m. Thursday, June 15. North's ceremonies for 353 students will be held in the school stadium, with School Board Members Clinton Cooke and Robert Ellis and Assistant Superintendent Albert Posner officiating. South's graduation of seniors will be at El Camino College, as Mrs. Grace Wright and Joseph G. Arnold and Assistant Superintendent Louis Kaplan officiate.

TORRANCE'S 255 graduates will get their diplomas from School Board President William C. Boswell and Assistant Superintendent S. E. Waldrip. Scene will be the school stadium. In Adult School rites, 176 persons will get their diplomas at the Torrance High Auditorium on Monday, June 12, at 8 p.m. from Charlton A. Mewborn, ex-school board member and Assistant Superintendent Albert Posner.
