### Estey Names Inventor to New Position

Fred G. Krueger, inventor of the "Krueger String Bass" for organs, has been named consultant electronic engineer at Estey Electronics, Inc., it was announced this week by Stanley Green, president.

Krueger will develop and design electronic musical instruments for Estey, the oldest organ manufacturer in the country.

The "Krueger String Bass" organ accessory, which Krueger introduced in 1956, was the first organ device using transistors.

Prior to joining Estey in 1959, Krueger was associated with United Precisioners, Inc., as consultant on the design of the Polaris missile, designed radio telephone equipment for Mobilphone Co., and worked in research and development of "Speed and Range" computers, Guided Missile Division, Raytheon. He has also been associated with the Thomas Organ Co. and Hammond Organ Co.

A native of Edgewood, Pa., Krueger attended Illinois Institute of Technology, Chicago. He lives at 22041 Crespi St., Woodland Hills.


