NOTICE INVITING BIDS ON \$1,000,000.00 GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF TORRANCE UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that sealed proposals for the purchase of \$1,000,000.00 par value general obligation bonds of Torrance Unified School District of Los Angeles County, California, will be received by the Board of Supervisors of said county at the place and up to the time below specified:

TIME: October 24, 1961 at 9:00 a.m.

PLACE: Office of the Board of Supervisors, Room 383, Hall of Administration, 500 West Temple Street, Los Angeles 12, California.

MAILED BIDS: Board of Supervisors, County of Los Angeles, Room 383, Hall of Administration, 500 West Temple Street, Los Angeles 12, California.

ISSUE: \$1,000,000 consisting of 1,000 bonds numbered 1 to 1,000 both inclusive of the denomination of \$1,000 each, all dated November 1, 1961 and designated "Election 1958, Series G."

MATURITIES: The bonds will mature in consecutive numerical order for each of the several years as follows:

INTEREST: The bonds shall bear interest at a rate to be fixed upon the sale thereof but not to exceed 5% per annum, payable annually the first year and semiannually thereafter.

PAYMENT: Said bonds and the interest thereon shall be payable in lawful money of the United States at the office of the Treasurer of the County of Los Angeles, in the City of Los Angeles, State of California, or at any of the fiscal agencies of the County of Los Angeles, in the City of Los Angeles, State of New York, State of New York, State of Illinois, at the option of the holder.

REGISTRATION: The bonds will be coupon bonds registrable only as to both principal and interest.

NOT CALLABLE: The bonds are not callable before maturity.

SECURITY: Said bonds are general obligations of said unified school district, payable both principal and interest from all valorem taxes levied under the laws now in force, which may be levied without limitation as to amount or source upon the taxable property, except certain personal property, in said unified school district.

TERMS OF SALE: The maximum rate bid may not exceed 5% per annum, payable annually the first year and semiannually thereafter. The rate bid must be a multiple of 1/8 of 1%. No bidder shall bid more than one interest rate. No bond shall bear more than one interest rate.

Award: The bonds shall be sold for cash only. All bids must be accompanied by a check for the amount of the bid and each bid shall state that the bidder offers par and accrued interest to the date of delivery, the premium, if any, and the interest rate not to exceed that specified herein, at which the bidder offers to buy said bonds. Each bidder shall state in his bid the total net interest in dollars and the average net interest rate determined thereby, which shall be considered informative only and not a part of the bid.

Highest Bidder: The bonds will be awarded to the highest responsible bidder or bidders considering the interest rate specified and the premium offered, if any. The highest bid will be determined by deducting the amount of the premium bid (if any) from the total amount of interest which would be payable to the date of maturity of the bonds and the award will be made on the basis of the lowest net interest cost to the district. The purchaser must pay accrued interest, computed on a 360-day year basis, from the date of the bonds to the date of delivery. The cost of printing the bonds will be borne by the district.

Right of Rejection: The Board of Supervisors reserves the right in its discretion, to reject any and all bids, to the extent not prohibited by law, to waive any irregularity or informality in any bid. Prompt Award: The Board of Supervisors will take action awarding the bonds or rejecting all bids not later than twenty-six hours after the expiration of the time herein prescribed for the receipt of proposals; provided that the award may be made after the expiration of the specified time if the bidder shall not have given to said Board notice in writing of the withdrawal of such proposal.

Place of Delivery: Delivery of said bonds will be made to the successful bidder at the office of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles, in the City of Los Angeles, California.

Prompt Delivery: Cancellation for Late Delivery: It is expected that said bonds will be delivered to the successful bidder within 30 days from the date of sale thereof. The successful bidder shall have the right at his option to cancel the contract of purchase if the district shall fail to execute the bonds and tender them for delivery within 60 days from the date of the sale thereof, and in such event the successful bidder shall be entitled to the return of the deposit accompanying his bid.

Form of Bid: Each bid, together with the bid check, must be in a sealed envelope, addressed to the Board of Supervisors of Los Angeles County, with the envelope and bid clearly marked "Proposal for Torrance Unified School District Bonds".

Bid Check: A certified or cashier's check on a responsible bank or trust company in the amount of 5% of the principal amount of the bonds payable to the order of the County Treasurer, must accompany each proposal as a guarantee to the bidder, if successful, will accept and execute the bonds in accordance with the terms of his bid. The proceeds of the check accompanying any proposal shall be applied to the purchase price or, if such proposal is not accepted, but performance shall be caused by any act or omission of the district, shall then be retained by the County Treasurer for the benefit of the district. The check accompanying each unaccepted proposal will be returned promptly.

Change in Exempt Status: At any time before the bonds are tendered for delivery the successful bidder may disaffirm and withdraw the proposal if the interest received by private holders from bonds of the same type and character to be declared to be taxable income laws, either by a ruling of the Bureau of Internal Revenue or by a decision of any federal court, or shall be declared taxable by the terms of any federal income tax law enacted subsequent to the date of this notice.

No Litigation Certificate: At the time of payment for any amount of said bonds the district will furnish the successful bidder a certificate that there is no litigation pending affecting the validity of the bonds.

Legal Opinion: A copy of the legal opinion of the attorney or firm of attorneys designated by the purchaser to give such opinion certified by the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles, in the City of Los Angeles, California, shall be printed on the back of each bond at the expense of the successful bidder.

Information Concerning the District: Torrance Unified School District has been acting as a unified school district since January 24, 1961. The assessed amount of the taxable property in said unified school district for the fiscal year 1961-62 is \$28,812,820.00 and the amount of bonds previously issued and outstanding as of September 26, 1961 is \$29,950,000.00. The percentage of tax delinquency for Torrance Unified School District for the last five years is as follows:
