





Neal received four weeks of training in various subjects with emphasis on leadership and combat tactics. The purpose of the academy is to broaden the professional knowledge of the soldier and to instill in him the self-confidence and sense of responsibility required to make him a capable leader of men. The 22-year-old soldier, a member of Company B of the 3rd Division's 4th Infantry in Bamberg, entered the Army in October 1960 and completed basic training at Ft. Ord, Calif. He was graduated from Narbonne High School in 1957 and attended Harbor College.
