

Garden Checklist

1. See your nurseryman and order new roses now to insure getting good plants when you want them.
2. Deciduous fruit trees and grapes may be pruned after the leaves fall.
3. Deciduous trees and shrubs show up in nurseries this month. The first step in planting them is a spacious hole which can be prepared in advance.
4. Special crabgrass controls should be applied this month. Your nurseryman will recommend one.
5. Plant the bright florist's cyclamen in sheltered outdoor gardens or in a light and airy sun porch.
