Know Your Traffic Laws
Prepared in Cooperation With the Torrance Police Department

A question asked many times by drivers is, what do I do when an emergency vehicle is approaching my vehicle?

Some drivers are under the impression you are required to stop immediately regardless of where your vehicle is. The law requires you to pull your vehicle as far to the right side of the street as you can and stop. If your vehicle is within an intersection, first clear the intersection and then pull to the right and stop. If traffic is heavy and you are unable to pull to the extreme right side of the street due to other vehicles going the same direction as yours, pull as far to the right as you can and then stop. Under heavy traffic conditions it may be necessary to double park but under these circumstances this would be permissible.

It is important that in addition to pulling to the right side of the roadway you stop your vehicle, not merely slow down or reduce the speed. You may wonder why this is important.

THE SIMPLE truth is that the driver of the emergency vehicle can better see what the condition of the roadway is ahead when the vehicles he is approaching pulls to the right and stops. It clears the road for the emergency vehicle thus making it possible for the emergency vehicle to get to the scene of the emergency faster. It is capable of giving better service to those in need of it, and reduces the danger by eliminating moving vehicles from the path of the emergency vehicle.

It is well to remember that an emergency vehicle does not respond to a routine call with red light and siren but when a true emergency does exist the dispatcher will send the unit with red light and siren in order to speed up the service. An emergency vehicle is authorized to use red light and siren only when life or property is in danger. This applies to any and all emergency vehicles regardless of what service they perform.

WHEN YOU SEE an emergency vehicle on a call you have no way of knowing what is the nature of the call they are on. Perhaps a police unit is on the way to a serious traffic accident, the fire truck may be going to a house fire, perhaps a child has swallowed poison, a member of a household has just had a heart attack, or many of the reasons an emergency vehicle may be called upon to respond.

If YOU were the one in need of the services of an emergency agency such as the police, fire department, or ambulance, would you accept an answer such as, "I'm sorry we couldn't get here any faster, but traffic was heavy and we were slowed down." If your son or daughter consumed some type of poison and you were riding in the rear of the police unit or ambulance would you condone fellow motorists failing to yield to that emergency vehicle? Those lost seconds could very well be the difference between life and death.

Remember the next time you are out driving and see an emergency vehicle responding to a call, some day you may need their service. Yield at all times to all emergency vehicles. You can assist this emergency vehicle by pulling to the extreme right side of the roadway and stopping.
