

## Marineland Opens Otter, Walrus Show

Four blubbery walrus and two playful otters are splashing happily in fancy new exhibit buildings at Marineland of the Pacific eagerly taking up a life of hand-fed luxury after being removed from the harsher surroundings of their natural environments.

William F. Monahan, vice president and general manager of Marineland, announced the new walrus pool and separate otter enclosure, costing a total of \$60,000, have been completed and now are open for public inspection.

"THE WALRUS exhibit," he said, "is one of the most remarkable things we have ever seen at Marineland. The animals are fed on a formula of minced clams, pure whipping cream, corn oil and vitamin supplement. They eat so much of this rich mixture that they gain more than one pound a day.

more than 100 pounds each when we rescued them from the disintegrating ice pack in the Bering Sea last summer. Now they weigh more than 300 pounds each and are still gobbling down their formula, plus and occasional tray of whole clams, at an unbelievable rate. At maturity they will weigh 2,000 to 3,000 pounds."

The walrus enclosure, situated just to the rear of the main oceanarium building, is a modernistic, contoured concrete arrangement of pools and ledges, including a tank of refrigerated water to simulate the icy sea which is their native habitat.

NEAR THE WALRUS quarters is a separate structure of fountains, ramps and pools where a group of fresh water otters now make their home.

These highly intelligent, agile and playful animals devote all their time to tireless

fun-making in their new domain.

Monahan said it is possible that the walrus and otters some day may be trained to perform in shows, just as the whales, dolphins and sea lions do now.

Although they are no real threat to the established stardom of the trained whales, Bubbles and Bimbo, the walrus and otters are expected to become among the most popular attractions at the oceanarium in 1962, as they become adjusted to their environment and learn new behaviors which will entertain the many visitors to the oceanarium.
