Spring Concert Saturday To Salute R. Neil Hill

Adding an international flavor with songs of various countries, El Camino College's annual Spring Concert takes place Saturday at 8:30 p.m. in the College Campus Center. As a tribute to the late R. Neil Hill, the a capella choir will sing Hill's own selection, "Here in America." Numbers representing England, Ireland, Scotland and Czechoslovakia, and German and Russian folk songs are included in the program. "Parley Moi D'Amour," a French selection, and "Sakura," a Japanese song are among the selections. Participating in the concert will be soloists, the a capella choir, mixed ensembles and small vocal groups. Spiritual and sacred hymns are scheduled as part of the concert program.
