ECC Faculty Elects New President

Richard C. Schwarzman, coordinator of audio visual services and history instructor, will head the El Camino College Faculty Assn. as president for the coming year.

Chairman of the faculty finance committee for the past year, Schwarzman is a resident of Manhattan Beach. He succeeds another beach resident and fellow Occidental College alum, Miss Virginia Pfiffner, in office.

Prior to his arrival on the El Camino College campus, Schwarzman taught in the city schools of Santa Barbara, Beverly Hills, and Los Angeles. In 1957 and 1958 he was the recipient of the Haynes Fellowship in Business History.

THE AUTHOR of several published articles in the field of history, the new president has traveled extensively in Europe, Mexico, Canada, and the United States. He has addressed a number of local service and special interest groups. He is currently continuing work toward a Ph.D. degree at the University of California at Los Angeles.

On the ECC Faculty Assn. legislative committee in 1959, he served the group as treasurer in 1960 before serving as chairman of the finance committee during the past year.

Miss Pfiffner received her associate in arts degree at El Camino College, her bachelor of arts degree in psychology at Occidental College, and her master of science degree in educational psychology from the University of Southern California.

IN ADDITION to a published book review, she is the author of a manual for use with an existing textbook "Physiological Psychology," by Wenger, Jones and Jones.

Prior to her post as president of the Faculty Assn., Miss Pfiffner served as secretary and vice president of the group. She holds membership in Psi Chi, an honorary psychology fraternity; Delta Kappa Gamma, a women's honorary education group, and
