

Supervisor Hahn Thanks City for Use of Jail

Supervisor Kenneth Hahn yesterday commended the cities of Inglewood, Torrance, Pasadena, and Glendale for "lending a helping hand" and housing felony prisoners in city jails while new county facilities were being built. Hahn pointed out that the

four cities housed 522 felony prisoners since Feb. 21, 1961, for a total of 7,022 inmate days.

"This assistance by the cities relieved county jails of the responsibility for an average of 20 prisoners a day," Hahn noted.

The cities were reimbursed a total of \$38,367.

Only prisoners who had not yet been sentenced were held in the city jails.

DUE TO added facilities at county correctional centers, the Board of Supervisors Tuesday voted to terminate its agreement for prisoner housing with the cities.

The board's action included commendation to the cities for their cooperation.

Bloodmobile To Stop Here On Aug. 23

Red Cross bloodmobile will visit Torrance from 2:30 to 7 p.m. Thursday, Aug. 23, at Elks Lodge No. 1948, 1820 Abalone.

Donors may make appointments by calling Mrs. Robert Orsini, 1519 Beech, Blood Program chairman, at FA 8-0647 or Red Cross at TE 2-8321.

During recent weeks Red Cross has issued an urgent appeal for donors of O-type blood to meet the demand created by the unusually large number of surgeries scheduled, Mrs. Orsini said.

Among the group participating in the bloodmobile will be the employees of Union Carbide Chemical who will be giving blood for a heart surgery patient. Most heart surgeries require from 16 to 20 pints of blood to operate the heart-lung machine which is necessary for the operation.


