RESOLUTION NO. 62-203
 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE, CALIFORNIA, DECLARING THAT PROCEEDINGS HAVE BEEN INITIATED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE TO ANNEX TO SAID CITY CERTAIN UNINHABITED TERRITORY DESCRIBED HEREIN AND DESIGNATED AS "LOMITA FLIGHT STRIP" ANNEXATION AND GIVING NOTICE OF THE PROPOSED ANNEXATION AND OF THE TIME AND PLACE FOR A HEARING THEREON.
 THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:
SECTION 1.
 That pursuant to the provisions of the "Annexation of Uninhabited Territory Act" of 1921, proceedings have been initiated by the Torrance City Council on its own motion to annex to the City of Torrance all that uninhabited territory situated in the County of Los Angeles, State of California, hereinafter designated as "LOMITA FLIGHT STRIP" annexation and described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof.
SECTION 2.
 That the City Council of the City of Torrance desires to annex said uninhabited territory to the City of Torrance for the following reasons: The territory is contiguous to the City of Torrance and its proposed annexation will contribute to and facilitate orderly growth and development of both the City and the territory proposed to be annexed; will facilitate and contribute to the proper and orderly layout, design and construction of streets, gutters, sidewalks, stationery and storm water drainage and sewer facilities both within the City and within the territory proposed to be annexed; and will provide and facilitate overall planning and zoning of lands and subdivision of lands in said City and said uninhabited territory.
SECTION 3.
 That the territory hereinafter described, prior to this meeting, pursuant to Section 35009 of the Government Code of the State of California, was submitted to the Boundary Commission of the County of Los Angeles for report upon the definiteness and certainty of the proposed boundaries of the territory hereinafter described.
SECTION 4.
 That the County Boundary Commission of the County of Los Angeles, at a meeting held on September 5, 1962, approved the boundary description of the territory proposed to be annexed as hereinafter described.
SECTION 5.
 That on October 30, 1962, at the hour of 5:30 p.m., at the City Hall, 3031 Torrance Blvd., Torrance, California, is hereby fixed as the time and place when and where any person owning real property within the uninhabited territory described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and proposed to be annexed to the City of Torrance and show cause why such uninhabited territory should not be so annexed to the City of Torrance. Such protest must be in writing and may be filed at any time before the hour set for hearing objections to the proposed annexation and shall state the name or names of the owner or owners of property affected and the description and area of said property in general terms.
SECTION 6.
 The City Clerk of the City of Torrance is hereby authorized and directed to cause a copy of this resolution to be published at least twice, but not more often than once a week, in the TORRANCE HERALD, newspaper of general circulation, printed, published and circulated inside the City of Torrance, but in the County of Los Angeles, and in the WILMINGTON PRESS JOURNAL & HARBOUR MAIL, a newspaper of general circulation published outside the City of Torrance, but in the County of Los Angeles; such publications to be completed at least twenty days prior to the date set for the hearing.
SECTION 7.
 The City Clerk of the City of Torrance is further authorized and directed to cause written notice of such proposed annexation to be mailed to each person to whom land within the territory proposed to be annexed was assessed on the last Equalized County Assessment Roll available on the date of passage of this resolution at the addresses which are shown on said assessment roll or known to said Clerk, and to any person who has filed his name and address and the designation of the land in which he has an interest, either local or equitable, with said Clerk. Such notice shall be given not less than twenty days before October 30, 1962.
SECTION 8.
 In the event there is upon the land proposed to be annexed to the City of Torrance a structure, improvement, right or interest owned, being acquired and/or leased by the County Fire Protection District, the City Clerk is further authorized and directed to cause written notice of such proposed annexation to be mailed to the governing body of such district. Such notice to be sent not less than ten days before the first public hearing upon such proposed annexation. The mailing of a copy of this resolution to each of the persons heretofore in this section mentioned at the time and in the manner provided by law shall constitute a sufficient written notice of such proposed annexation.
SECTION 9.
 The City Clerk is authorized and directed to cause written notice to be given to such other persons as may be legally entitled thereto in the manner provided by law.


