Pacific State Bank To Open on Oct. 26

The new Torrance office of Pacific State Bank is nearing completion and public grand opening ceremonies have been

set for Friday, Oct. 26. President Robert C. Yeary announced yesterday.

Hollywood Model Judith Ann Swanson will preside over many special day-long activities from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. as a Cinderella version of "Miss Pacific State Bank."

Visitors will be conducted through the facility by Manager Keith Pischel and other personnel of the bank's newest branch addition.

The 7,300 sq. ft. structure, which is being completed by Ernest W. Hahn, Inc., general contractor, is designed for maximum economy of construction. It has a 5,500 sq. ft. ground floor with a 1,800 sq. ft. "floating" mezzanine.

ALL DESIGN accents have been placed on the main entrance of the building which will be framed by a portico

of tubular steel columns supporting an overhang projection extending from the front of the building.

Of unusual interest is the contemplated use of floor-to-ceiling alternating gray and amber glass windows in the front and rear of the building—one of the few cases of such use in a commercial building.

The office's ground level vault structure will be used to support mechanical equipment which will be placed above it on the mezzanine.

OTHER INTERIOR features of the Bank will include acoustical tile ceilings, recessed lighting and air-conditioning and an interior color selection include beige, soft yellow blue and blue-gray. Modern open-type counters will be built of aluminum and wood and circu-

lar service islands will be placed in the center of the main lobby.

The Bank has other offices in Hawthorne, Lennox, Windsor Hills, and Rolling Hills.



Dividends Hiked by Dial Finance

Edward Glazer, president of Dial Finance Co., Des Moines, Iowa, after action of the board of directors on Oct. 3, announced the declaration of a quarterly cash dividend of 27½ cents per share of common stock for shareholders of record on Oct. 15, to be paid Nov. 6. This was the first increase in Dial's dividend rate, which had been at 25 cents per quarter, since the company's stock was offered to the public in May, 1960.

The next dividend meeting is on Jan. 2, 1963.

As previously announced, Dial's earnings were \$1.17 per share in the first half of 1962 compared to 98 cents per share in the first half of 1961. Glazer stated preliminary figures indicate Dial's earnings for the first nine months of 1962 will be ahead of the \$1.50 per share earnings for the first nine months of 1961. Final figures will be available for release about Oct. 25.

Dial has established 28 new offices in 1962 and now operates 205 offices in 28 states. Dial Finance Co. common stock is traded in the National Over-the-Counter market.


