NOTICE INVITING BIDS ON \$500,000.00 GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF TORRANCE UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that sealed proposals for the purchase of \$500,000.00 par value general obligation bonds of Torrance Unified School District, County of Los Angeles, California, will be received by the Board of Supervisors of said county at the place and up to the time below specified.
TIME: October 22, 1962 at 9:00 a.m. California Daylight Saving Time.
PLACE: Office of the Board of Supervisors, Room 383 Hall of Administration, 500 West Temple Street, Los Angeles 12, California.
MAILED BIDS: Board of Supervisors, County of Los Angeles, Room 383 Hall of Administration, 500 West Temple Street, Los Angeles 12, California.
ISSUE: \$500,000.00 consisting of 500 bonds numbered 1 to 500 both inclusive of the denomination of \$1,000 each, all dated November 1, 1962 and designated Election 1968, Series J.
MATURITIES: The bonds will mature in consecutive numerical order on November 1, in the amounts for each of the several years as follows:

SIGNATURES: At least one of the signatures to the bonds shall be manually affixed.
INTEREST: The bonds shall bear interest at a rate or rates to be fixed upon the sale thereof but not to exceed 5% per annum payable annually the first year and semi-annually thereafter.
PAYMENT: Said bonds and the interest thereon are payable in lawful money of the United States at the office of the Treasurer of the County of Los Angeles, in the City of Los Angeles, State of California, or at any of the fiscal agencies of the County of Los Angeles, in the City of New York, State of New York, or in the City of Chicago, State of Illinois, at the option of the holders.
REGISTRATION: The bonds will be coupon bonds registerable only as to both principal and interest.
NOT CALLABLE: The bonds are not callable before maturity.
SECURITY: Said bonds are general obligations of said district, payable both principal and interest from ad valorem taxes which, under the laws now in force, may be levied without limitation as to rate or amount upon all of the taxable property, except certain personal property, in said district.
TERMS OF SALE
Interest Rate: The maximum rate bid may not exceed 5% per annum, payable annually the first year and semi-annually thereafter.
Each rate bid must be a multiple of 1/8 or 1/20 of 1%. No bond shall bear more than one interest rate, and all bonds of the same maturity shall bear the same rate. Only one coupon will be attached to each bond for each installment of interest thereon, and bids providing for additional or supplement coupons will be rejected. Not more than 4 interest rates may be bid. The repetition of any rate will not be considered as a bid rate of an additional rate. The rate on any maturity or group of maturities shall not be more than 1/4% higher than the interest rate on any other maturity or group of maturities.
Award: The bonds shall be sold for cash only. All bids must be for not less than all of the bonds hereby offered for sale and each bid shall state that the bidder offers par and accrued interest on the bonds and the interest rate or rates not to exceed that specified herein, at which the bidder offers to buy said bonds. Each bidder shall state in his bid the total net interest cost in dollars and the average net interest rate determined thereby, which shall be considered informative only and not a part of the bid.
Highest Bidder: The bonds will be awarded to the highest responsible bidder or bidders considering the interest rate or rates specified and the premium offered, if any. The highest bid will be determined by deducting the amount of the premium bid (if any) from the total amount of interest which would be required to be paid from the date of sale of the bonds to the date of maturity of the bonds at the coupon rate or rates specified in the bid and the award will be made on the basis of the lowest net interest cost to the district. The purchaser must pay accrued interest, computed on a 360-day year basis, from the date of the bonds to the date of delivery. The cost of printing the bonds will be borne by the district.
Right of Rejection: The Board of Supervisors reserves the right, in its discretion, to accept any and all bids and to the extent not prohibited by law to waive any irregularity or informality in any bid.
Bids not to be returned: Bids not to be returned or rejected after the time specified in the notice of sale and after the expiration of the time herein specified, provided that the award may be effected after the expiration of the time specified in the notice of sale if the bidder shall not have given the said Board notice in writing of the withdrawal of his proposal.
Place of Delivery: Delivery of said bonds will be made to the successful bidder at the office of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles, in the City of Los Angeles, California.
Prompt Delivery: Cancellation of Late Delivery: If the successful bidder fails to deliver the bonds within 30 days from the date of sale, the successful bidder shall have the right, at his option, to cancel the contract of the interest received by the district, or to execute the bonds and tender them for delivery within 60 days from the date of sale; the successful bidder shall be entitled to the return of the deposit accompanying his bid.
Form of Bid: Each bid, together with the bid check, must be in a sealed envelope, addressed to Board of Supervisors of Los Angeles County, with the envelope and bid clearly marked "Proposal for Torrance Unified School District Bonds".
Bid Check: A certified or cashier's check on a responsible bank or trust company in the amount of 3% of the principal amount of the bonds, payable to the order of the County Treasurer, must accompany each proposal as a guaranty that the bidder, if successful, will accept and pay for said bonds in accordance with the terms of his bid. The proceeds of the interest-earning any accepted proposal shall be applied on the purchase price or, if such proposal is accepted but not performed, unless such failure of performance shall be caused by any act or omission of the district, shall then be retained by the County Treasurer for the benefit of the district. The check accompanying each unaccepted proposal shall be returned promptly.
Change in Tax Exempt Status: At any time before the bonds are tendered for delivery the successful bidder may disaffirm and withdraw the proposal of the interest received by the private holders from bonds of the same type and character shall be declared to be taxable income under present federal income tax laws, either by a ruling of the Bureau of Internal Revenue or by a decision of any federal court, or shall be declared taxable by the terms of any federal income tax law enacted subsequent to the date of this notice.
No Litigation Certificate: Any of the payment for and delivery of the successful bidder a certificate that there is no litigation pending affecting the validity of the bonds.
Legal Opinion: A copy of the legal opinion of the attorney or firm of attorneys designated by the purchaser to give such opinion certified by the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, or by his deputy, by his fac-

simile signature will be printed on the back of each bond at the expense of the successful bidder if requested in his bid.
Information Concerning the District: Torrance Unified School District has been acting as a unified school district under the laws of the State of California continuously since January 24, 1947.
The assessed valuation of the taxable property in said unified school district for the fiscal year 1962-63 is \$250,890,500.00 and the amount of bonds previously issued and outstanding as of September 11, 1962 is \$23,940,000.00.


NOTICE INVITING BIDS ON SCHOOL SUPPLIES AND REPAIRS
Notice is hereby given that the Board of Education of the Torrance Unified School District, County of Los Angeles, California, will receive bids for furnishing certain school supplies and equipment as set forth in list and specifications on file in the Business Office, 2355 Plaza del Amo, Torrance, California.
Each bid must be submitted on a printed form furnished by the Board of Education and sealed and filed in the Business Office on or before Friday, October 26, 1962, at 4 P.M. and will be opened in public at that time and place. Each bid aggregating \$1,000 or over must be accompanied by a certified or cashier's check for not less than 5% of the total amount of bid; provided that if one or more items of a bid are accepted the bidder may thereupon substitute a certified or cashier's check for 5% of the aggregate amount of the accepted items on his bid and providing further that firms doing business regularly with the Board of Education may at the discretion of the Business Office and in lieu of the above mentioned check file with the Torrance Unified School District, an annual or continuing surety company bond in the sum not less than \$5000.00 to insure compliance with the terms of their signed proposals submitted from time to time during the life of the bond.
The above mentioned check or bidder's bond shall be given as a guarantee that the bidder will comply with the terms of his signed bid; and if the successful bidder fails to comply with the terms of the signed bid, after acceptance thereof by the Board, his check or bond will be forfeited.
Preference shall be given to supplies, materials or equipment produced, manufactured or grown in the State of California.
