

Undefeated El Camino Invades Border City

With a perfect 3-0 record on the line, El Camino gridders travel to San Diego Saturday night to engage the border city Knights.

El Camino saw its vaunted defense partially crumble last Saturday when East Los Angeles broke loose for two first quarter scores. The Warriors struck back in the second stanza for three tallies and kept the pressure on for a 31-21 decision.

Pat Lininger, a fleet second-string end from North High, caught two touchdown passes of 52 and 54 yards from quarterback John Torok in leading the Tribe to victory in the Metropolitan Conference opener.

TOROK RETURNED to action following a two-week lay-off and tossed three scoring aerials, completing 15 of 21 passes for 256 yards.

Lininger and Torok were chosen Lineman and Back-of-the-Week respectively by the Camino coaching staff.

EAST LOS ANGELES scored early in the contest when quarterback Rick Harris went off tackle from one yard out. Harris passed to end Todd Androvich for the two-point conversion.

Jess Willard, a 9.6 sprinter tallied for the Huskies when he weaved his way over from two yards out. The conversion failed.

THE WARRIOR'S scoreless drought ended when Jerry Thagard broke around end for

a four-yard tally. Bill Kelley kicked the extra point. Torok's two long bombs to Lininger closed out the scoring in the second half, with the Warriors holding a 19-14 lead.

EL CAMINO increased its spread early in the third quarter as Torok hit end Herb Hinsche on a five-yard score.

Mike Jones, a substitute quarterback, revived the Huskies' offense when he burst through a quick opening and scored on a 15-yard run. Joe Perkov added the conversion.

THE TRIBE's last tally came in the final quarter when Jim Allison scored on a four-yard scamper around end.

San Diego will attempt to rebound from last week's 13-6 defeat at the hands of Cerritos. It was the first Knight loss of the season.

QUARTERBACK Dale Helzer has rejuvenated the San Diego offense with scoring aerials to ends John Nettles and Bob Buckman. George Barnes, a

5-8, 170-pound halfback, has anchored the border city ground game.

Barnes gained 119 yards for a 7.3 average in the Knights' 20-0 win over Compton.

Other San Diego backs with impressive averages are Adam Cato, 7.3 yards-per-carry, and Preston Davis with a 5.4 average.

Ascot Park Schedules Two Events

Racing patrons will get their choice of two entirely different sports at Ascot Park this weekend.

Tomorrow night, the fastest motorcycle riders of the season will be tossed on the track in an attempt to shatter the one-lap track record.

Expert Stu Morley, 22.75 seconds; amateur Elliott Schultz, 22.95 seconds, and novice Dick Guglielmana, 24.81 seconds, will be joined by three other riders at intermission in the attempt to break the record.

STANDARD-BREAKING attempts will be in addition to the regular 15-event program, headlined by the 15-lap main event, which is expected to be a duel between Jack O'Brien and Al Gunter. Racing begins at 8:30 p.m., with time trials opening the program at 7 p.m.

A new racing innovation, the Flying Wing, will spotlight Saturday night's San Diego Racing Assn. super modified sprint car races at Ascot.

THE FLYING WING is an aeroplane-type, semi-horizontal wing which is secured on top of the auto's cowl, preventing slideouts and causing better weight distribution on the car's wheels, especially in the turns.

Although Jimmy Wood utilized the Wing for the first time on the West Coast three weeks ago, at least eight drivers are expected to use the new device Saturday.

Point Lead In Danger At Western

More than 50 top stock car drivers, led by California Jolopy Assn. point leader Marvin Heinis, will take part in Saturday night's Fall Championships at Western Speedway.

Heinis, winner of four main events at Western, has only a five-point lead in the fight for the 1962 CJA crown.

Pressing Heinis is Bill Foster, who trails 2235 to 1240, with two feature wins to his credit.

JIM COOK, with six main event victories, is third in the point battle with 2065 points. Any of the top three could wind up in the lead after Saturday's racing.

Racing begins Saturday at 8:30 p.m.

IT WILL be a doubleheader for the stock cars this weekend as they also take to the Gardena oval Sunday afternoon starting at 2:30.

A 30-lap main event tops action on both cards. Also slated is a 15-lap semi-main, four eight-lap heat races, an eight-lap handicap dash, and a four-lap trophy dash. Time trials begin at 7 p.m. Saturday.
