Funeral services for Jarvis Weiss, vice president and treasurer of Consumers Mart of America, Inc., (CMA) were held in Phoenix, Ariz., Tuesday. Mr. Weiss died Saturday at the age of 47.

A graduate of Fordham University, he was the son of the late Dr. Henry Weiss of Phoenix, and had made his home in Phoenix since 1948.

New Schedule Begins Nov. 12



