Hi-Shear Names Korb As Ordnance Manager

The appointment of Monte W. Korb to the position of ordnance engineering manager was announced recently by George S. Wing, president of Hi-Shear Corp.

As ordnance engineering manager, Korb directs the over-all activities of Hi-Shear's Ordnance Section. His responsibilities include supervision of design, development, testing and research as well as the manufacture, application and qualification of Hi-Shear's electro-combustion products.

Prior to joining Hi-Shear, Korb was deputy director of Army Ballistic Missile Agency, research and development operations, Propulsion Systems Laboratory, Redstone Arsenal, Huntsville, Ala., from 1960 to 1962. While employed by Thiokol Chemical Corp. from 1951 to 1960, Korb advanced to chief of design section. From 1950 to 1951, he was engineer in charge of the mold yard department of Bethlehem Steel, Sparrows Point, Md.

Korb received a bachelors degree in mechanical engineering from Georgia Tech and for two years, he taught mathematics there.

Korb is a registered professional engineer and is a member of a number of engineering societies including the American Rocket Society and the American Society of Professional Engineers. He has published numerous technical papers and has many patent applications pending.
