Appeal for World Missions Opened Here by Adventists

The 59th Annual World Missions Appeal, sponsored by the Torrance Seventh-day Adventist Church, opened Saturday evening with house-to-house calls accompanied by Christmas carols.

Leading the volunteer workers participating in the four-week citywide drive is Louie Miller, church home mission director. The goal here is \$3397.

Funds will go toward extending welfare, disaster aid, and educational services at home as well as a widespread medical, welfare, and educational ministry in 195 other countries.

The local church operates a welfare center at 1610 Acacia St. Persons in need of assistance or knowing others needing material aid may phone FA 8-1540 or DA 6-6280.

On a world basis, volunteer Adventist workers in 1961 gave 7,593,047 hours in welfare services to 7,179,073 persons. More than \$1,545,000 in cash, some 6,706,493 articles of clothing, and 4,192,238 food baskets were contributed. Approximately 50 per cent of this aid was given in North America.

Seventh-day Adventist members themselves contributed more than \$99,902,355 last year toward the support of their world church program, in addition to welfare activities.
