

Only 102, He Takes Sabin II to Insure Daily Two-mile Hike

You're never too old to be careful... Take it from spry but cautious Edward E. Apalakis, 102, the oldest known beneficiary of the Southland's current Sabin polio vaccine mass immunization program... The still stalwart ex-blacksmith, who was born on the island of Crete, off Greece, the year Abe Lincoln made it to the White House, has taken his Type II vaccine, on top of Type I a month ago, and believes everybody should go and do likewise... The Type II clinics will be repeated Sunday from 11 a.m. to 6 p.m. throughout the county.

In 1932, came to the United States the same year and became a citizen shortly after. He has five children, eight grandchildren, 10 great-grandchildren. On the social side he regularly attends conventions of the Pancretan Assn. of America, which greets him as this nation's oldest living Cretan, and three weeks ago he joined Silver Age, an Arcadian social club for retired folk, who "play cards, dance, etc." "I've lived to see a lot of miracles," the young-old man said thoughtfully. "Sabin vaccine is one of the greatest. But I'll tell you one thing—you've got entirely too much smog..."

"IT'S WONDERFUL to have the chance," he declared. "Every morning before breakfast I take a two-mile walk. I'd hate to come down with polio at my age and lose that opportunity!" The cheerful and chatty centenarian-plus-two, who vows that after being bald for 70 years he's starting to get a new crop of hair that's coming in black, lives with his youngest daughter, Mrs. Charles H. Sullivan, 48, and her family, 2304 Freeborn St., Bradbury. Until two years ago he lived alone in Stoneham, Mass. Getting restive to "see the country — and on a bus," he made an unannounced journey to the coast and has lived here since.
