They include Junction Transistor Electronics, Monday, Feb. 4, and Tuesday, Feb. 5 from 7 to 9:30 p.m.; Linear System Solutions by Transform Methods, Thursday, Feb. 7; Art of Dress, Monday, Feb. 4 from 4:30 to 6:30 p.m.; The Management of Behavioral Problems in School, Wednesday, Feb. 6 from 4 to 6:30 p.m.;

TEACHING FOREIGN Language in Elementary Schools, Monday, Feb. 4 from 7 to 9:30

p.m.; Government Contract Administration, with sections Wednesday and Thursday, Feb. 6 and 7; Advanced Personnel Management, Tuesday, Feb. 5 from 6:45 to 9:35 p.m.; and Commercial and Investment Properties, Tuesday, Feb. 5 from 7 to 9:30 p.m.

Boat Registration Renewals in Mail

Boat registration renewal has been sent to more than 300,000 California boat owners. The re-registration is the first required of boat owners since California's boat registration law became effective in 1960. The fee will be \$3 for three years beginning Jan. 1.

Lachlan M. Richards, chief of the Division of Small Craft Harbors, said the boat owner

can renew his registration by mailing a renewal fee and the IBM card he will receive this month to the Division of Small Craft Harbors in Sacramento, or he may go to one of the division's authorized undocumented vessel registration agents and present the card and fee.

THE NEW sticker is tough and durable and highly resistant to water, sun, salt and wind damage. Boaters whose stickers weather out in the years ahead may obtain replacements from the division. Richards said boaters will have until Feb. 4, 1963 to renew registration without penalties.

Boats registered for the first time after Dec. 31, 1962, will also have to show the stickers to indicate that the boat is registered for the period January, 1963, to Dec. 31, 1965. The fee for an original registration in 1963 will be \$5 for the three-year period. Boats registered in 1964 will cost \$4 for the two years of 1964 and 1965. Boats registered for the first time in 1965 will cost \$3 for one year or fraction. Registration of all boats will require renewal again beginning Jan. 1, 1966.
