To Staff**

Appointment of Dr. Stuart Ridgway to the position of technical director was announced by General Technology Corp., 3510 Torrance Blvd. In this new position Dr. Ridgway, who joined GTC early in 1962, is responsible for directing the company's research and development programs. He will continue to conduct selected research projects in quantum electronics.

Prior to joining General Technology, Dr. Ridgway was for six years a member of the senior staff in the research laboratory of Ramo-Wooldridge Corp. and Space Technology Laboratories where he was engaged in the study of lasers and the development of automotive air pollution control devices. He is prominent in the field of air pollution control, having invented a successful direct flame afterburner for use on automobiles.

Dr. Ridgway has authored eight technical papers whose subjects are in the above fields and in nuclear physics. Two patents have been issued in his name and eight more of his patents are now pending. He is a member of the Motor Vehicle Exhaust Committee of the Air Pollution Control Assn., the American Physical Society, the American Nuclear Society, and the Combustion Institute.

**Over 200,000
Veterans Use
Cal-Vet Loan**

California war veterans took out 12,630 farm or home loans under the Cal-Vet Farm and Home Purchases Program during 1962, according to a year-end report made by director of veterans affairs Joseph M. Farber to Gov. Edmund G. Brown of the veterans board. The total value of the loans was placed at \$168,523,000.

Farber said this brings the total number of loans made during the life of the program to over 200,000, and the total amount of money loaned to around \$1,340,671,000.

"As always," said Farber, "none of this has been taken from the taxpayers' pockets. It's been a self-supporting program all the way."

The report also indicated the Department had assisted 13,470 California veterans to establish claims with the federal government during 1962; and that there was an increase in the number of veterans' dependents being assisted under the Educational Assistance Program.
