

District Attorney Backs Anti-Smut Bill

By CHARLES E. CHAPEL, Assemblyman, 46 District. The honorable James Don Keller (usually referred to as Jim Keller), district attorney, San Diego County, in a letter to me dated Feb. 14, commented

favorably on my Assembly bills combating obscene materials in these words: "Dear Charlie: Thank you very much for sending the copies of your

A. B. 3 and A. B. 14 and asking our comments. "We believe these bills provide a greatly needed answer to the problem of the volume of pornography which is being foisted upon every community

and area of our state. The present provisions of Section 311 of the Penal Code, particularly the wording 'and is matter which is utterly without redeeming social importance' make prosecution of this sec-

tion exceedingly difficult and the possibility of successful prosecution highly questionable, no matter how viciously obscene the matter may be. The proposed legislation would delete this wording.

"I am confident that every legitimate news media and the respectable editors and publishers of the state will lend support to these bills. Certainly there is nothing contained in the bills which enroaches

upon freedom of the press under Supreme Court definitions. "I am sure that the District Attorneys' Assn. and the Peace Officers' Assn. will strongly support the bills. "I hope you have had an op-

portunity to meet the District Attorneys' Assn. representative in Sacramento. If you are in contact with him, you can tell him that these bills have my fullest approval. "With every wish for a splendidly successful session.

ANY CITIZEN of California can obtain free copies of any bill by writing to the Legislative Bill Room, Room 215, State Capitol, Sacramento 14. If you want my two anti-obscenity bills, simply say: "Please send two free copies of A. B. 3 by Chapel and A. B. 14 by Chapel. There has been such a heavy demand for these bills that you can get the bills much faster if you enclose a stamped, self-addressed envelope. If you want more than two copies of each bill, ask the Legislative Bill Room for the cost of the quantity you want. The price is low because each of these bills is comparatively short. However, if you want a quantity after learning the price, you may have to wait a week or two because when the supply in the bill room is exhausted, additional copies must be ordered from the State Printer. Please do not write to me for copies of these bills because my free supply is exhausted.

AFTER YOU have read the bills please write to your own member of the Assembly and your own state senator. If you do not know the name of your own assemblyman, ask your city clerk or any other public official in your area. The same applies to the senator. If you do not know the room number of your own assemblyman or state senator, simply address your card or letter to him, setting forth his name and title and then the words "State Capitol, Sacramento 14, Calif." They are all men with one exception.



District Attorney Don Keller of San Diego is sending me the latest revised list of all the District Attorneys in California. At my own expense I am sending copies of my A. B. 3 and A. B. 14 to them for their comment with the hope that when the bills are set for hearing before the Assembly Judiciary Committee and later before the Senate Judiciary Committee, they will come to Sacramento and testify in favor of these bills which are vital to the welfare of California.
